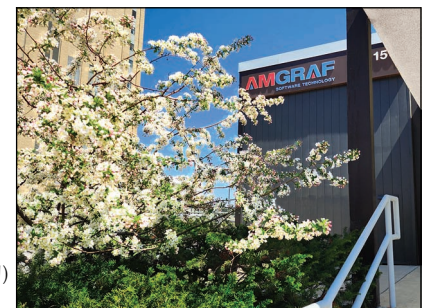

Highlights in the History of Amgraf, Inc.

- 1976 - Amgraf founded by Franklin J. Garner, III and Robert Kisel. Developed GRAFICA
- 1977 - Amgraf opens its first offices in Kansas City's historic Union Station
- 1979 - Launches MECCA™ (Mechanical Editor for Computer Created Artwork)
- 1982 - Amgraf relocates its main offices into downtown Kansas City, Missouri
- 1982 - MECCA II runs on IBM 370 mainframes
- 1984 - MECCA III was born. Over the next 14 years 1,500+ MECCA III systems delivered
- 1992 - Introduction of the Pixelace™ Security Feature
- 1997 - OneForm™ Designer developed for Windows PC electronic forms
- 1998 - MECCA 2000 introduced to replace MECCA III
- 2000 - Develops Stationery Option for the online ordering of imprinted documents
- 2003 - Develops method to convert Content Metadata XML into fillable forms
- 2004 - Begins hosting e-commerce web sites
- 2005 - Develops eForms Accessibility Option for visually handicapped persons
- 2006 - Nominated Best Software and Best Technology Provider at Gartner Print & Imaging Summit
- 2007 - Amgraf receives U.S. Patent No. 7,196,822 for the LogoDot security document technology
- 2008 - Implements an online artwork ordering Void Pantograph Service called VoidMaker™
- 2009 - Opens the eForm Solutions and Services center
- 2009 - Franklin Garner receives Jo Warner award from the Business Forms Management Association
- 2010 - Adds international language support to OneForm Designer Plus
- 2015 - Contracts with U.S. Census Bureau to develop an international forms design system
- 2017 - Amgraf sponsors PRISM, the Public Retirement Information Systems Management association
- 2018 - Developed HTML5 code generation extensions to design and deploy mobile-device e-forms
- 2019 - Processed the 800th secure online application for VoidMaker Pantographs
- 2020 - Introduces Graphing Software to connect Forms Portal data to interactive charts and graphs
- 2021 - OneForm Accessibility is enhanced to support PDF/Universal Accessibility ISO 14289
- 2022 - Integrated DocuSign Electronic Signature and Remote Notary into the Amgraf's Forms Portal
- 2023 - MECCA QRCode generator was integrated into OneForm Designer Plus - Universal (OFDP-U)
- 2024 - Enhanced our Variable Merging Software Option with Artificial Intelligence (AI) features
- 2025 - Contracted again with U.S. Census Bureau to maintain and manage the Census Automated Forms Engine (CAFE) Servers
- 2026 - Amgraf celebrates its 50th year in business in 2026, the same year the United States celebrates 250 years as a nation

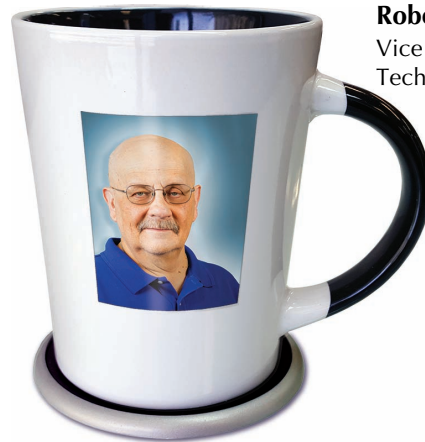
