WHEREAS, AMGRAF, owns certain patents relating to anti-counterfeiting technology, which are disclosed or claimed in U.S. Patent Number 6,692,030 and U.S. Patent Number 7,196,822; and

WHEREAS, AMGRAF additionally own a substantial body of trade secret technical information and know-how, and expects in the future to develop additional information and know-how relating to such inventions, which AMGRAF asserts that it has been and shall be maintained in strict secrecy; and

WHEREAS, LICENSEE desires to apply said inventions and trade secret technical information to a commercial product line; and

WHEREAS, LICENSEE desires access to and use of the trade secret property, as well as a non-exclusive license of the patents described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, it is agreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1 - DEFINITIONS:

As used in this agreement, the terms:

1.1 "Document" means any bank note, check, certificate, coupon, title, receipt, other document or media or other physical object capable of having information or images recorded thereon.

1.2 "Patent" or "Patents" means inventions owned by AMGRAF that are generally described in the Patents listed in Appendix A hereto.

1.3 "Product" means any Document disclosed or claimed within any of the Patents, or whose methods of manufacture are disclosed or claimed within any of the Patents, or which embodies or is made with the use of any of the Trade Secrets.

1.4 "Software" means any electronic files supplied by AMGRAF to LICENSEE.

1.5 "Documentation" means any information provided by AMGRAF pertaining to the recommended methods and techniques for using the Software.

ARTICLE 2 – SOFTWARE LICENSE GRANTED

2.1 Subject to payment of applicable license fees, AMGRAF grants LICENSEE a non-exclusive license to use the Software and accompanying documentation ("Documentation") in the manner described below:

LICENSEE may:

- Use the Software on any computer located at the business address indicated on LICENSEE's License Application form;
- Use the Software on a network, provided that each person accessing the Software is located at the business address indicated on LICENSEE's License Application form; and
- Copy the Software for archival purposes, provided any copy must contain all of the original Software's proprietary notices.

LICENSEE may not:

- Use the software at any other location outside of the business address indicated on LICENSEE's License Application form;
- Permit other individuals to use the Software except under the terms listed above;
- Permit unlicensed use of the Software;
- Modify, translate, reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble (except to the extent applicable laws specifically prohibit such restriction), or create derivative works based on the Software;
- Copy the Software other than as specified above;
- Rent, lease, grant a security interest in, or otherwise transfer rights to the Software; or
- Remove any proprietary notices or labels on the Software.

ARTICLE 3 – TECHNOLOGY LICENSE GRANTED

3.1 AMGRAF hereby grants to LICENSEE a world-wide non-exclusive license to manufacture, have manufactured, sell, offer to sell, and export Products created using the Software.

3.2 AMGRAF reserves all rights to apply for and obtain Patents for Trade Secrets or knowledge derived from LICENSEE's use of the Software before such becomes common knowledge.

3.3 Except under specific written permission from the AMGRAF, LICENSEE is strictly prohibited from sublicensing of this Agreement to any third party, and this Agreement shall, in all instances, specifically preclude the sublicensee from granting further sublicenses, and require the sublicensee to maintain the Trade Secrets in strict confidence.

ARTICLE 4 – TRADEMARK LICENSE NOT GRANTED

4.1 The rights to use AMGRAF's Trademarks and/or Trade Names are not included in this license. LICENSEE agrees that it will not use any of AMGRAF's Trademarks listed in Appendix A hereto in association with the sale or marketing of Products.

4.2 LICENSEE agrees that it will not distribute or sell any Products bearing AMGRAF's Trademarks without prior written approval of AMGRAF.

4.3 LICENSEE acknowledges that AMGRAF is the owner of the Trademarks, and agrees that it will do nothing inconsistent with such ownership and that all use of the Trademarks by LICENSEE shall inure to the benefit of and be on behalf of AMGRAF. LICENSEE agrees not to adopt any trademark that is confusingly similar to the AMGRAF Trademarks. LICENSEE also agrees that nothing in this Agreement shall give LICENSEE any right, title or interest in the Trademarks. LICENSEE further agrees that it will not attack AMGRAF's title to the Trademarks.

ARTICLE 5 – TITLE.

5.1 Title, ownership rights, and intellectual property rights in the Software shall remain in AMGRAF and/or its suppliers. The Software is protected by the copyright laws and treaties. Title and related rights in the content accessed through the Software are the property of the applicable content owner and may be protected by applicable law. This License gives you no rights to such content.

ARTICLE 6 – TERMINATION.

6.1 The license will terminate automatically if you fail to comply with the limitations described herein. On termination, you must destroy all copies of the Software and Documentation.

ARTICLE 7 – LIMITED WARRANTY.

7.1 Amgraf warrants that for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of acquisition, the Software, if used as directed, will substantially achieve the functionality described in the Documentation. Amgraf does not warrant, however, that

your use of the Software will be uninterrupted or that the operation of the Software will be error-free or secure. In addition, the security mechanisms implemented by Amgraf software have inherent limitations, and you must determine that the Software sufficiently meets your requirements. Amgraf also warrants that the media containing the Software, if provided by Amgraf, is free from defects in material and workmanship and will so remain for ninety (90) days from the date you acquired the Software. Amgraf's sole liability for any breach of this warranty shall be, in Amgraf's sole discretion: (i) to replace your defective media; or (ii) to advise you how to achieve substantially the same functionality with the Software as described in the Documentation through a procedure different from that set forth in the Documentation; or (iii) if the above remedies are impracticable, to refund the license fee you paid for the Software. Repaired, corrected, or replaced Software and Documentation shall be covered by this limited warranty for the period remaining under the warranty that covered the original Software, or if longer, for thirty (30) days after the date (a) of shipment to you of the repaired or replaced Software, or (b) Amgraf advised you how to operate the Software so as to achieve the functionality described in the Documentation. Only if you inform Amgraf of your problem with the Software during the applicable warranty period and provide evidence of the date you purchased a license to the Software will Amgraf be obligated to honor this warranty. Amgraf will use reasonable commercial efforts to repair, replace, advise or refund pursuant to the foregoing warranty within 30 days of being so notified.

7.2 THIS IS A LIMITED WARRANTY AND IT IS THE ONLY WARRANTY MADE BY AMGRAF. AMGRAF MAKES NO OTHER EXPRESS WARRANTY AND NO WARRANTY OF NONINFRINGEMENT OF THIRD PARTIES' RIGHTS. THE DURATION OF IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, IS LIMITED TO THE ABOVE LIMITED WARRANTY PERIOD; SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW LIMITATIONS ON HOW LONG AN IMPLIED WARRANTY LASTS, SO LIMITATIONS MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. NO AMGRAF DEALER, AGENT, OR EMPLOYEE IS AUTHORIZED TO MAKE ANY MODIFICATIONS, EXTENSIONS, OR ADDITIONS TO THIS WARRANTY. If any modifications are made to the Software by you during the warranty period; if the media is subjected to accident, abuse, or improper use; or if you violate the terms of this Agreement, then this warranty shall immediately be terminated. This warranty shall not apply if the Software is used on or in conjunction with hardware or software other than the unmodified version of hardware and software with which the software was designed to be used as described in the Documentation. THIS WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC LEGAL RIGHTS, AND YOU MAY HAVE OTHER LEGAL RIGHTS THAT VARY BY JURISDICTION.

ARTICLE 8 – EXPORT CONTROLS.

8.1 None of the Software or underlying information or technology may be downloaded or otherwise exported or reexported (i) into (or to a national or resident of) Cuba, Iraq, Libya, Yugoslavia, North Korea, Iran, Syria or any other country to which the U.S. has embargoed goods; or (ii) to anyone on the U.S. Treasury Department's list of Specially Designated Nationals or the U.S. Commerce Department's Table of Denial Orders. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES AND UNDER NO LEGAL THEORY, TORT, CONTRACT, OR OTHERWISE, SHALL AMGRAF OR ITS SUPPLIERS OR RESELLERS BE LIABLE TO YOU OR ANY OTHER PERSON FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY CHARACTER INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF GOODWILL, WORK STOPPAGE, COMPUTER FAILURE OR MALFUNCTION, OR ANY AND ALL OTHER COMMERCIAL DAMAGES OR LOSSES. IN NO EVENT WILL AMGRAF BE LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNT AMGRAF RECEIVED FROM YOU FOR A LICENSE TO THE SOFTWARE, EVEN IF AMGRAF

SHALL HAVE BEEN INFORMED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES, OR FOR ANY CLAIM BY ANY OTHER PARTY. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OR LIMITATION OF INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, SO THIS LIMITATION AND EXCLUSION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.

ARTICLE 9 – HIGH RISK ACTIVITIES.

If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unenforceable, such provision shall be reformed only to the extent necessary to make it enforceable. This Agreement shall be governed by Missouri law (except for conflict of law provisions). The application the United Nations Convention of Contracts for the International Sale of Goods is expressly excluded.

10.2 U.S. GOVERNMENT RESTRICTED RIGHTS. Use, duplication or disclosure by the Government is subject to restrictions set forth in subparagraphs (a) through (d) of the Commercial Computer-Restricted Rights clause at FAR 52.227-19 when applicable, or in subparagraph (c)(1)(ii) of the Rights in Technical Data and Computer Software clause at DFARS 252.227-7013, or at 252.211-7015, or to Amgraf's standard commercial license, as applicable, and in similar clauses in the NASA FAR Supplement.
